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HOUSE INFO



PARKING

You can park on the sidewalk in front of the apartment to unload your luggage. You can park for free at the Segeerssingel and Oude Veerseweg car parks in Middelburg. This is about a 5 and 15 minute walk.

Opposite our house is a parking garage called 'Kousteensedijk' where you can park a whole day for € 18.50 or € 2.10 per hour. It is paid parking in Middelburg from 08:00-20:00.

WIFI

The name of the wifi is Number 9 and the password is Offline!

WINE

If you feel like having a glass of wine, feel free to grab a bottle. The prices are on the label. They all come from the wine shop on the corner "12% or more" and they are our personal favorites.

BOODSCHAPPEN

The Spar City (Segeerstraat 15-17) is just around the corner, a more extensive range can be found at the Albert Heijn (Pottenbakkerssingel 2). Bakery Opdorp across the street has delicious bread. Fromagerie Forianne has the best meat and cheese in the area.

HOUSE INFO



GARBAGE

A pass for the underground container hangs in the hallway below, by the front door. When you step outside you will find the container to the right of our house by the water.

SUN

The sun shines on the front of the house the morning, making it warm inside. It is useful to leave the blinds down during the day.

BICYCLES

You can rent bicycles at Rijwielshop Middelburg (Kanaalweg 22) or the Cycle hub (Stadsambachtweg 6). You can store bicycles in the hall or in front of our house. The 2 Veloretti bicycles can be used for free by guests. You cannot reserve them, they are for all guests so put the keys back (don't take them to the room). The keys hang in the hallway, near the front door. It is at your own risk, if something breaks you have to have it repaired yourself and please lock the bikes properly.

CHECK OUT

You can check out until 11am, you can leave the keys on the counter and close the door behind you.

OTHER THINGS

- The countertop is sensitive for wine and oil stains. If you spill something, please clean it.
- Smoking and burning candles don't go with our old house :)
- Our beautiful old house is noisy, so be kind to the neighbors below in terms of noise.
- The plants do not need to be watered
- Umbrellas hang at the front door
- In the hall you will find a bistrosset that you can put in front of the house to enjoy

OUR FAVORITE SPOTS

NICE COFFEE



SINT JOHN

It is perhaps the oldest café in Middelburg. You can drink coffee all day here, read the paper or eat delicious yogurt ice cream. It is a place where time stands still and that is sometimes exactly what you need.

ROOS EXPRESSO BAR

This is the newest coffee shop in Middelburg and it is only a few doors away from our house. It's Roos her dream that came true, and we always love dreamers. The coffee (and tea) tastes delicious, but don't forget to add a cake or a freshly baked croissant.

LUUKS PATISSERIE

Luuk works for days on his sourdough bread. And you can taste his love for bread when you have some. The traditional approach ensures the tastiest breads in Middelburg. You can also enjoy breakfast or lunch there. Chances are that you will also have some cake because those are a piece of art.

You want to buy everything when you walk into the fromagerie. There are shelves full of irresistibly tasty cheeses and meats. But, what you wouldn't expect is that you can walk through the store and end up at their lunchroom with terrace. A hidden spot in the middle of the city center where you can enjoy breakfast or lunch.

This is the very nice coffee shop with all day breakfast. Ideal if you like to sleep in, just like us. The coffee (and tea) tastes delicious, but what makes them unique is that they also prepare it in a good way: organic, with as little waste as possible and products from the region. NICE LUNCH



HET KASLOKAAL

You don't expect it, but if you walk through the old nursery you will find yourself in a beautiful tea garden. The chickens walk around freely, the lemonade is homemade and the atmosphere is relaxing. We like to have lunch in the shade under the tree and forget what we were actually going to do that day.

DE JUF

Ooooh, they are irresistible; all the tasty cakes from De Juf. We have already eaten ourselves nauseously, because we just can't stop. You can also have a delicious breakfast. We prefer to sit at the window with a view of the damplein. De Juf is just around the corner from our house. They are one of the few places that are open for breakfast/lunch on sunday.

We love to have breakfast or lunch at this place around the corner of our house, It was here that we made the first plans for our renovation, in the sunshine on the small terrace. The interior is cheerful, the food delicious, the owners friendly and the view nice. There is also a play corner for children.

ENJOY DINNER



SILVY'S GUSTI E SAPORI

Homemade pastas and irresistible desserts. This Sardinian lady makes delicious food with her husband and is definitely our favorite Italian. Do not expect pizzas but original and pure dishes. It is just a one minute walk from our home!

LA PRESA

We get hungry when we think of La Presa. We eat as often as possible at this fantastic tapas restaurant. They don't serve Spanish tapas, but tapas from all parts of the world. The small bites provide a taste explosion in your mouth, the atmosphere and friendly service make it complete. Don't forget to try a cocktail, the specialty of owner Jesse.

DE HERBERG

In the middle of the city center, good food, but still slightly different: that is De Herberg. This restaurant feels more like a living room where you want to hang out all night. It is beautifully decorated inside, but sitting outside is also very nice.

ENJOY DINNER



EL MOSQUITO

We feel like we are in Spain when we sit here with delicious tapas and a glass of wine. They have a nice garden where you are in the middle of the city but you don't hear the city at all. This is the place to be for traditional Spanish tapas,

GOUDEN BOCK

This is a lovely seafood restaurant, just a few minutes walk from our house. The wine is fantastic, the fish even better and the service extremely friendly. At the Gouden Bock you get small original worldly fish dishes that you can also share. They also have a very nice terrace where we like to drink a glass of wine.

BASALT

You will find another nice fish restaurant a few minutes walk from our house named Basalt. On the menu you will find genuine Zeeland products such as crinkles, mussels and lobster. Basalt is all about the fish and you get it served in its pure form.

DE HOUTZAAGWERF

We think this is really the gem of Zeeland. It looks like you're in France, but you're actually in a sawmill where the daughters of the lumberjack started a restaurant. Not many tourists know this place, but the local people love it. So make sure to book in advance. Also a nice place if you are going to eat with children. Address: Oud Kortgenedijk 2, Kortgene

DE VISBAR

If you want to eat fresh fish, this is the place to be. They serve everything from the sea that is locally and sustainably caught and full of flavour. From sushi and oysters to sea bass and shrimp, the choice is endless. The interior is cheerful and light and the atmosphere cozy. Ideal to combine with a day at the beach in Domburg.




MEZGER

Would you like to dine in style? Then we can definitely recommend restaurant Mezger in Domburg. We celebrated our anniversary here. Take your time and enjoy all the dishes. The interior is less exciting, but the food and service are just as good as the restaurant.

NICE BEACH PAVILION



KON-TIKI

We have been coming here for years. It is easy to park there, the path to the beach is short and Kon-Tiki itself has a wonderfully laid back atmosphere. Children can also play on the beach while you sit on a picnic table with a drink.

ZEECAFE

It is actually a kind of construction shack, but very hip and made from wood. Het Zeecafe is a very nice, small beach pavilion where you can drink a beer with your feet in the sand. We think this is the coolest pavilion in Zeeland.


Address: Oostkapelle duinweg, Oostkapelle (in front of the parking lot) then cross the dune crossing, turn right on the beach and walk a few minutes. Closed from November to February



PIER 7

If we want to quickly make it to the beach with a drink in our hand, we will go here. You can park on the boulevard, walk down the stairs, sit down in a chair on the sand and look at the big ships that pass by. Ideal if you have children because they can literally play in front of you on the beach.

NICE BEACH PAVILION



DE BOTANIST

This new beach pavilion in Dishoek is nicely decorated, with plants and bright colours. You can eat tasty tapas, order a fresh beer and enjoy the sunset. Sounds like a nice ending to a lovely day at the beach

BOMBAAI STRANDBAR

You can hear Latin music in the background, order street food from all over the world (the wasabi bitterbal is our favorite), and treat yourself to a cocktail in this colorful beach pavilion near Westkapelle. We love the relaxed beach vibe which is slightly different from that in a traditional beach bar.

ZEEUWS VLAANDEREN



If we are honest, we are a bit jealous of the beach pavilions in Zeeuws-Vlaanderen because they are really great. Fortunately, you can get there really easy by boat from Vlissingen:
Pure C - beach pavilion by Sergio Herman in Cadzand
Moio Beach - beach pavilion near Cadzand where you can also have many surfing activities
Beach pavilion Puur - near Groede

BEST BEACHES




ZOUTELANDE

Although the village itself is perhaps a bit gloomy, the dunes are incredibly beautiful! You have to climb a lot, but the view is great. These dunes are the second highest in the Netherlands and are no less than 54 meters above sea level. We often take the dune crossing at Groot-Valkenisse because it is quieter there.

ORANJEZON

If you love nature and the beach, you have to go here! It is a long walk to the beach but you will pass by a forest and dune grassland. With a little bit of luck, you can spot a deer! The beach itself is very wide and has a nice beach pavilion.

DISHOEK



When we finish the work on our house, we like to go to the beach for just an hour. We always end up in Dishoek. The parking is easy, the beach bars fun and it is close to our house. You can go to the Galgeweg (beach pavilion Kon-Tiki) but also to the Strandweg (beach pavilion De Botanist) where it is a bit quieter. Both are located in Koudekerke.

ENJOY ACTIVITIES



ZEEUWS-VLAANDEREN

"The other side" is what we call Zeeuws-Vlaanderen (and they call us). Here you will find beautiful beaches and perhaps even better beach pavilions. You can cycle to Vlissingen, hop on the boat (20 minutes) and arrive in Breskens. You can cycle along the coastline all the way to Knokke and visit Het Swin (nature area) on the way, the Friettent of Sergio Herman or the cute town of Sluis. Skip Terneuzen because that is less beautiful.

FORMER ESTATES

Walcheren used to have many beautiful country estates. We love to drive to a few remaining houses and castles and try to imagine what it is like to live there. Take a drive past Castle Westhoven and country estate Overduin in Oostkapelle, country estate Ter Boede in Koudekerke and Welgelegen in Serooskerke.



TOUR BOAT OR SUPPEN

Would you like to see our house from the water? Then board the canal boat or rent a sup. It is lovely to do with warm weather. The tour boat is close to Honey Pie, a lovely tea house with a terrace on a boat, the beautiful building Kloveniersdoelen, which also houses the cinema, and the shopping street Lange Viele. ENJOY ACTIVITIET



RENT A BOAT

We feel so lucky that not only beaches are nearby, but also the Veerse Meer. You can rent a boat (also without a license) and enjoy a day on the lake. Bring food and drinks, dock at one of the uninhabited islands and have a nice picnic or go for a swim. You can rent different types of boats at www.watersportverhuurbedrijfdearne.nl

CINEMA

It is a small cinema, with only two or three arthouse films a week but it is so cute! It is in the beautiful Kloveniersdoelen from 1607 which is fun to watch and you can also have a drink in the garden.

WANDERING AROUND

Our favorite activity is walking through the old streets. Everywhere you come, you will see small alleys that are almost hidden. Streets you should definitely see: De Kuiperspoort, Abdij, area around Spanjaardstraat, Spuistraat, Suikerpoort and Isabellagang, Pijpstraat, around the Oostkerk, Verwerijstraat and then to the Bolwerk, Vismarkt. You can also make a city walk with a guide. Check the current times at the Drvkkerij.

ELECTRIC SCOOTER

It is great to cycle, but sometimes you just don't want to move that much. After all, it is vacation! You can now rent an electric scooter at Scoot-e in the street next to our house. ZEEUWS MUSEUM

In the beautiful Abbey you will find a special museum. Every room is a surprising combination of the city's history with the modern times of today. Also very nice for children to go to! Another impressive museum is the Watersnoodmuseum in Ouwkerk, where you can learn everything about the 1953 disaster that hit Zeeland in particular.

STREETTOUR



If you want to know more about the history of the city, then take a walk along the street tour. On this special tour called "Stegentocht", the guide shows you the small alleys of the city, he tells you all the exciting stories from the past and you immediately drink a beer in the café. ENJOY ACTIVITIES



VEERE

It feels like you are walking around in a museum. Do not miss this beautiful old harbor town. It is within cycling distance of our house and it is fun to visit for half a day. We especially like to walk over the old citywalls. You walk between the cows and can cross the water with a draft raft!

ANTWERPEN

Middelburg is fun, but sometimes we want something different. We like to jump into our car and drive to Antwerp. A beautiful city, where it is nice to shop and it is only a 45 minute drive from our house. We always visit the Kloosterstraat. Here we also had our first date so that makes it our favorite place anyway :)



VEERSE KREEK

If you want to do something different then visit the beach, then it is definitely recommended to go to the Veerse Kreek. You cycle past the cute village of Veere and end up in a beautiful nature reserve where you can walk, picnic and swim in the lake. And if you feel like going to the beach, you can cycle to the beach in Vrouwenpolder.

- Sebastian den Herder: for the most beautiful vintage clothing
- Hoplala: the happiest beer and cider shop
- Intussen: where several entrepreneurs sell their items in a concept store.


The last auction


All the floors had to go out

Then the contractor came to help us with the rough work, such as renewing the roof, electricity and pipes. The walls were placed and we could finish it up to the apartment as it is now. Every place you see has been refurbished with a lot of love!



APARTMENT J
